Opioid medications (e.g.-Vicoden, oxycodone, etc.) and Heroin are currently being abused in epidemic proportions. This one hour lecture with a 20 minute demonstration will provide the proper training to any person interested in saving lives from opioid overdose.

Completion of this training program will qualify participants in the proper administration of Narcan, the antidote for opioid overdose. This qualification protects the responder under the NYS “Good Samaritan” law.
